



In this project for the Public Facilities Department of the City of Boston, HMFH was retained to develop the program requirements for a 1,000 student high school and subsequently to design the facility. Included in this project is a 53,200 square foot physical education building containing gymnasium and a swimming pool which was completed in March of 1976. The Academic Building houses a major auditorium which can be sub-divided into three lecture classrooms. It has dressing room and a stage for theatrical productions to be used by students and the community. The building also houses typical classrooms, laboratory facilities, library, art studios, home economics classrooms, drafting and vocational education shops and a greenhouse. The Charlestown High School and Community School received the Walter Taylor Award, presented jointly by the American Association of School Administrators and the American Institute of Architects in 1980.
